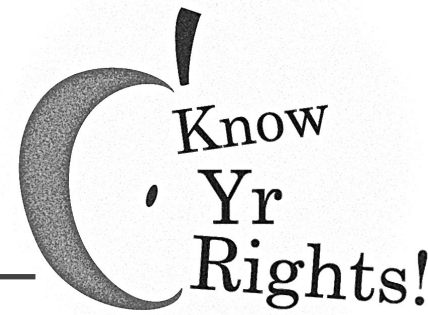
On August 31, the TDSB sent a letter to all principals about school dress codes.
